

Town Center Area Community Improvement District Project Updates

Project Name: Noonday Creek Multi-Use Trail

Project Description: The Noonday Creek Multi-Use Trail is a 6 mile continuation of the Mountain to River trail which currently ends at Kennesaw Mountain National Battlefield Park. The Town Center Area CID is the lead agency responsible for developing this project which will extend through the CID to Bells Ferry Road. The project will follow Noonday Creek approximately 2.7 miles to provide a peaceful and scenic area to walk or bike. The first section of the trail will follow Old US 41 and Ridenour Road through Kennesaw Mountain Park and then along Greers Chapel Road and US 41 to Noonday Creek. The trail will leave the creek and follow a portion of Vaughn Road, Cobb Place Boulevard, and Barrett Lakes Boulevard to reach Noonday Creek again. The trail will then parallel the creek crossing under I-75, over Busbee Parkway, behind Town Center Mall, under I-575 and under Chastain Meadows Parkway and then to its end at Bells Ferry Road. The width of the trail will vary between 20 feet and 24 feet in width.

Project Schedule: Design is currently scheduled for completion in the summer of 2006

Current Phase of Implementation: The project is currently in the preliminary engineering/design phase.

Specific Project Status: The project is currently in the preliminary plans phase of development with the right-of-way plans and final plans phases to follow.
